Information Diamond Tours Trip to Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard, Plymouth Rock

The Greene County Senior Center is sponsoring a trip through Diamond Tours the week of September 24th through September 29th, 2018. The cost of the trip per person for double occupancy is \$525 which includes motorcoach transportation, 5 nights lodging-(one on the way up, 3 nights in Cape Cod, and one on the way back), 8 Meals-5 Breakfasts & 3 Dinners, A guided Tour of Hyannis, Admission to the JFK Museum, a visit of lovely Martha's Vineyard, Guided Tour of the Outer Cape including Provincetown & Chatham, a visit to Plymouth Rock, Massachusetts, and much more-see Trip Flyer. Cost also includes Gratuities for the Motor Coach Driver & Tour Guides. If you choose to have a Single Occupancy Room, the cost is \$710. The Tour reference number is 1421950.

Number of Persons Needed to Make a Trip: Minimum amount needed for a trip is 40, but reservations can be for as many as 52.

Eligibility: Our target age for trips is 55 and older. Permission must be granted for Adults under age 55 who wish to sign up for this trip, with the understanding that the group will be made mostly of **Older Adults**, no children included. You **DO NOT** have to be a resident of Greene County to participate.

Registration: At the time the initial deposit is paid, participants will need to complete a Trip Registration Form and give information for the **rooming list**-we will need to know your roommate for double occupancy rooms. Be prepared to give your name, address, phone number, birthdate, and a contact number for a responsible party in case of emergency.

About Trip Costs: Trip costs vary depending on the location and duration of stay. A **non-refundable** \$75 Deposit is due upon signing for the trip. **Final payment due date: 7/17/2018** Reimbursements-(excluding deposit) for individual cancellations will be made and honored up to **two weeks prior** to departure, **provided that the total remains at 40 Paying Participants** needed to make a trip. Please note that refunds will be administered through the Travel Company, and not the Greene County Senior Center. To make payments, **Checks and Money orders must be made out to Diamond Tours**, which is the travel company. The Senior Center will collect the payments, and mail to the travel company. The Senior Center will **not accept cash** towards the cost of trips or trip insurance. If the **trip has to be cancelled** by the Tour Company or there is not enough participants to make a trip, individuals will receive a refund of **all monies** including the deposit.

Rooming Assignments: Rooming assignments-no more than 2 per room. There is an increase in price for Single Occupancy Rooms as specified above. In some cases, couples may be placed in a room with a single King Sized Bed at no additional charge. Rooms are assigned according to the rooming list submitted to the travel company. These rooms may or may not be clustered together, or on the same hall.

Participant Trip Seating: No seats will be reserved. The seat the participant chooses initially will be their seating during the entire trip. If participants agree to switch seats with another participant, they may do so, but all must be in agreement. Please inform the staff of the seating change.

Bathrooms on the Motorcoach: Motor coaches are equipped with a bathroom, which should only be **used sparingly** and **only as necessary**. Motor Coach Drivers will make frequent restroom stops, and additional stops as necessary. Please let the staff know if an additional stop needs to be made along the way. We hope to prevent unpleasant smells on the bus by limiting use of the Motor Coach Bathroom Facility.

Optional Travel Insurance offered when you pay your initial trip Deposit:

At the time you make your initial trip deposit, you can purchase travel insurance through the Travel Confident Protection Plan. A separate check should be made out to **Travel Insured International**, and given to the Senior Center Director or Programs & Activities Coordinator at the time you pay your \$75 Trip Deposit to Diamond Tours. Passengers may also purchase travel insurance themselves online with credit card. Information about the Protection Plan is on the back of the travel flyer including what the plan covers, costs, and benefits. **You must purchase Travel Insurance within 14 days of writing your check for your initial trip deposit.** The Senior Center will not accept cash towards the cost of trip insurance-check or money order only. For this trip, you will need to purchase the **\$45** plan.
