Campaign Finance:

Candidates have 10 days post-filing to submit *Statement of Organization* paperwork (regardless of Office sought, all filers establish a Committee & therefore must adhere to NC Campaign Finance law). It is recommended to use the state-provided campaign finance reporting software for all report filings. If you have a previous campaign committee with our office, please be sure to notify Election Official & verify all information is current and accurate.
